SUMMARY ANNUAL REPORT

This is the summary annual report for the l.B.E.W. Local Union 306 Supplemental Health Benefit Fund, EIN 34-0308380, Plan number 501 for the period June 1, 2012 to May 31, 2013. The annual report has been filed with the Employee Benefits Security Administration, as required under the Employee Retirement Income Security Act of 1974 (ERISA).

Basic Financial Statement

Benefits under the plan are provided by a trust (benefits are provided in whole from trust funds). Plan expenses were \$1,195,036. These expenses included \$48,118 in administrative expenses and \$1,146,918 in benefits paid to participants and beneficiaries. A total of 247 persons were participants in or beneficiaries of the Plan at the end of the plan year.

The value of plan assets, after subtracting liabilities of the plan, was \$2,642,424 as of May 31, 2013 compared to \$2,152,094 as of June 1, 2012. During the plan year, the plan experienced an increase in its net assets of \$490,330. This increase includes unrealized appreciation or depreciation in the value of plan assets: that is, the difference between the value of the Plan's assets at the end of the year and the value of the assets at the beginning of the year, or the cost of assets acquired during the year. The plan had total income of \$1,685,366 including employer contributions of \$401,545, employee contributions of \$1,168,922, and earnings from investments of \$114,899.
