**SUMMARY OF MATERIAL MODIFICATIONS**  
**FOR THE SUMMARY PLAN DESCRIPTION OF THE**  
**OHIO CONFERENCE OF PLASTERERS AND CEMENT MASONS**  
**HEALTH AND WELFARE FUND**

The Trustees have made a change that will affect the provisions of your Plan. This “Summary of Material Modifications” explains this change and should be kept with your Summary Plan Description.

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**Processing of Qualified Medical Child Support Orders (QMCSO)**

- I.** ERISA requires the Plan’s Administrative Manager to honor court orders or administrative court directives (i.e., medical child support decrees) to provide medical plan coverage to children and/or other “alternate recipients” and to begin such coverage while you are working.
- These orders must meet the QMCSO rules, which require that certain federal standards be satisfied. The Plan’s Administrative Manager will deny medical plan coverage under any judgment, decree or order as a “Qualified Medical Child Support Order” unless it satisfies all of the requirements set forth below. Assuming such Order meets these federal requirements, the Plan’s Administrative Manager will follow the terms of the Order if this Plan is the proper party to the legal proceeding from which the Order has been issued.
- II.** The Plan’s Administrative Manager will follow court orders or administrative court orders that meet all of the following requirements:
- a. The Order relates to the provision of medical child support order.
  - b. The Order creates or recognizes the existence of an alternate recipient’s right to medical coverage under the participant’s medical benefits.
  - c. The Order specifies the social security number, name, birth date, and last known mailing address of the participant and each alternate recipient covered by the Order.
  - d. The Order specifies the type and period of medical coverage and requires that such coverage be paid by the participant in accordance with the medical plan and federal law.
  - e. The Order specifically names the Ohio Conference of Plasterers and Cement Masons Health and Welfare Fund as the Plan to which the Order applies.
  - f. The Order does not require this plan to provide any type of medical coverage, benefit(s), or form of coverage or option(s) not otherwise provided under this plan.
- III.** Upon request to the Administrative Manager, you will be provided with a copy of the Plan’s Procedures for Processing Medical Child Support Orders.
